TEXAS SUPREME COURT JUSTICE DALE WAINWRIGHT TO SPEAK AT “JUSTICE FOR ALL” LUNCHEON MARCH 24, 2009

Fort Bend Lawyers Care (FBLC) announces Texas Supreme Court Justice Dale Wainwright to be the keynote speaker at the “Justice for All” Luncheon. The Master of Ceremonies is Matt Probus, President of Fort Bend Lawyers Care. The third annual “Justice for All” Luncheon presented by The West Law Firm honors its volunteer lawyers and non lawyer volunteers who assist low income residents of Fort Bend County with their legal needs. The luncheon will be held at the Safari Texas Ranch on Tuesday, March 24, 2009. 11:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Justice Dale Wainwright was elected to the Supreme Court of Texas on November 5, 2002, and re-elected in 2008. Justice Wainwright has served on the board of directors of the Houston Bar Association, the Houston Volunteer Lawyers Program and the Texas Young Lawyers Association; and served as president of the Houston Young Lawyers Association.

Prior to his appointment to the bench, Justice Wainwright practiced in the trial sections of the firms of Haynes and Boone and Andrews & Kurth in Houston. He earned his law degree from the University of Chicago Law School, studied at the London School of Economics and earned his undergraduate degree from Howard University, summa com laude, and was valedictorian of his high school graduating class. He and his wife, Debbie, have three sons – Jeremy, Phillip, and Joshua.
